

Feeney® CableRail Stair Kit

for use with wood stair railings





Step 1: Installing the Threaded Terminal

• Threaded Terminal Fittings should be installed on the post at the bottom of the stairs



Drill 5/16" angled hole through the threaded terminal post.



Feed Threaded Terminal through the end post.



Attach washer, beveled washer, and the Snug-Grip® washer nut. Spin nut 2 to 3 full turns.



Step 2: Installing Quick-Connect® Pivot Fitting

- Quick-Connect® Pivot Fittings should be installed on the post at the top of the stairs
- **DO NOT** attempt to install the Hanger Bolt with the Quick-Connect® Fitting attached, or you may damage the fitting.



Drill 7/64" pilot hole for lag. Harder woods may need larger hole.



Spin Hanger Bolt Installation Tool onto the end of the bolt.



Drive hanger bolt into post using socket or electric drill.



Drive until threaded section protrudes approx. 1/2" from post face.



Spin fitting onto the hanger bolt until it bottoms out.



Stretch cable tight across fitting and mark at Cut Gauge Line. Cut cable at mark.



Insert cable all the way into Quick-Connect® fitting until it stops. Jaws will lock automatically.

Step 3: Final Tension and Finish



Return to the Threaded Terminal post. Tighten the Snug-Grip® washer nut to tension the line. See tensioning sequence at right.



Trim excess threads and install End Caps
